
Laparoscopic Surgery





Laparoscopic surgery is a minimally invasive surgical technique used in both humans and animals. A 5mm surgical telescope is inserted through a small keyhole sized incision. This camera allows surgeons to view magnified organs on a monitor. Additional small incisions are

made to facilitate the use of surgical instruments, and surgeons can perform a more precise, less painful surgery, avoiding the traditional large incisions.

Advantages of Laparoscopic Surgery

- Smaller incisions in your animal
- Less pain and bruising
- Faster recovery
- Less blood loss
- Quicker return to normal activity
- Allows for same-day return home
- Excellent visualization of organs
- Less scarring





Common Applications

- Diagnostic Laparoscopy
- Laparoscopic Spay
- Ear Video Otoscopy for ear cleaning
- Bladder Stones
- Nose Nasal Exam and Biopsy
- Laparoscopic Gastropexy for GDV or Bloat
- Soft Palate Resection

This approach is safer and less painful; providing faster healing and quicker return to normal activity than traditional open procedures. We perform these procedures in our operating room. In most situations your pet is able to return home the same day as the procedure.
